Print and play board game

For 1 to 6 players, with a 20 minute playtime

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE GAME:

- Downloadable and printable player sheet (printing required; laminating is recommended for reusability);
- 30 downloadable and printable Job Advertisement cards and 6 Europass-tool cards (must be printed before play);
- 6–10 standard six-sided dice (D6).

GAME SETUP:

- Each player takes a player sheet and a pen.
- Shuffle the 36 cards and create a 6x6 grid with the cards face down.
- Prepare the dice based on the number of players: 2 players - 6 dice; 3 players - 7 dice; 4 players - 8 dice; 5 players - 9 dice; 6 players - 10 dice.

HOW TO PLAY:

- Choose a starting player.
- The starting player rolls all the dice and chooses either:
 - All dice of a single value (e.g., all 5s), OR
 - Exactly two dice with different values (one of each).
- The player then uses the selected dice to either:
 - Record the values on their player sheet, OR
 - Reveal as many cards from the grid as the number of dice chosen. (If you take two 5s, you can write down two 5s (one in each chosen slot), flip over two cards, or combine these actions: write down one 5 and flip one card.)
- If you reveal a card but cannot claim it, flip it back face down.
- If you reveal a card and meet its requirements, you claim it.


To obtain this card, you need three 5s for Qualification, at least two 5s for Experience, and the total sum of your Cover Letter values must be greater than 36.

- The next player must choose from the remaining dice. In rare cases, if no dice are left when it is your turn, you cannot choose any dice in that round.
- For the next round, the player to the left of the previous starting player becomes the new starting player and re-rolls all the dice.

THE PLAYER SHEET:

- Qualification and Experience: In each row, you may only record identical values (e.g., three 3s). This means that out of the 6 possible dice values, you will use only 3 for each of these sections.
- The values chosen for Qualification do not have to match the values chosen for Experience.
- You can freely record any dice values in the Cover Letter section, where only the total sum of the numbers matters.

SPECIAL CARDS:



- Europass Profile: If the total value of your chosen dice in a round exceeds 6, you may claim this card to gain the ability to re-roll one of your dice at any time, which must then be used for an action.
- Europass Portal: If the total value of your chosen dice in a round exceeds 8, you may claim this card to gain the ability to peek at one face-down card at the start of your turn before performing any actions.
- Europass Certificate Supplement and Diploma Supplement: If the total value of your chosen dice in a round exceeds 10, you may claim this card to gain the ability to modify the value of one of your dice by plus or minus one at any time.

END OF THE GAME:

- The game ends in the round when a player claims their 5th Job Advertisement card.
- Each card you have claimed is worth as many points as the number of dice shown on it, ranging from 2 to 5 points. The player with the highest total score wins the game. In the event of a tie, the game has multiple winners.

SOLO MODE:

- The game can be played alone using 6 dice, following the standard rules with no other players to choose from the dice pool.
- The game lasts for exactly 15 rounds, meaning the player rolls and chooses dice 15 times.
- After performing your actions in each round, you must discard one face-down card from the grid without looking at it, constantly reducing your available options.

COOPERATIVE MODE:

- Although job hunting is often a real competition, you can also play this game collaboratively.
- The gameplay remains the same, but you are encouraged to share all acquired and memorized information with each other instead of playing against one another.
- If every player finishes with more than 10 points, your performance was excellent.
- If only one player finishes with fewer than 10 points, you performed well.
- If more than one player ends up with fewer than 10 points, you should play another round, because the job hunt was not very successful.
